Safety!!!

At first, tying your shoe is a lot of work and requires 100 percent of your attention! But eventually, your hands learn to do the trick and you can free up your mind for other things.

If you were going to go sky diving, you wouldn't just hop in a plane, throw a pack over your shoulder, and jump, would you? You'd learn how to skydive first. You wouldn't go scuba diving, without preparing for it, would you dive without knowing how much air you had? You would never go mountain climbing without preparing yourself. Would you just grab any rope and try to scale a mountain. Would you do it after a few beers? Would you go in a tee shirt and any shoes? NO! You would study, learn first how to do it, get the best equipment, and take precautions to protect yourself. It's a risky activity. It only hurts if you fall. In all these activities we would stay within the limits of our ability.

Motorcycling is just like these activities, it's not dangerous till you screw up. If you screw up, it very well could cost you your life. So, you take precautions. You know your limits! You know your machine / equipment. You're aware of the risks, and you're consciously managing them. An intelligent motorcyclist does every thing in his or her power to reduce the risk

Three simple rules can help you minimize the risks you take on you motorcycle.

RULE 1: Predict the future and insure your place in it (Ride defensively; know what the other drivers are doing)

RULE 2: The more you practice, the LUCKIER you get!

RULE 3: You can prevent every crash. (Look, Listen, See, it's you life!)

Get the best suit, the best helmet, and the best gloves. Treat your self—you'll be glad you did.
